NIL ADVOCATES

Understand NIL Eligibility & Rules

- Confirm if your state, school district, and league allow NIL for high school athletes.
- Research your athlete's high school, club, and state association's policies (ask coaches and athletic director if unsure).
- Talk with your athlete about college eligibility: Some contracts or posts can impact NCAA/NAIA recruitment.

Protect Your Athlete's Name, Image, and Social Media

- Review your athlete's social profiles together—remove risky or unprofessional posts.
- Check for clauses in any contract about how, where, and for how long your child's image can be used.
- Require final approval rights for any brand content or promotional posts.

Evaluate Every NIL Offer—Before You Respond

- Get any offer, contract, or DM in writing —never agree verbally or over text.
- Ask: WHO is making the offer? (Brand, local business, social "marketing" agent?) Research them online.
- Look for red flags: too-good-to-betrue money, pressure to sign quickly, or no clear contract terms.

Don't Jeopardize College Opportunities

- Confirm with your athlete's current AND potential future schools that any NIL activity won't impact recruitment or scholarships.
- Double-check that all deals comply with NCAA, state, and high school association policies.
- Save a copy of all contracts, payments, and communications (including screenshots).

Financial Literacy = Safety

- Track NIL payments—know who's paying, when, and for what work.
- Plan for taxes! If your athlete earns more than \$600/year, they may need to file.
- Open a separate account for NIL earnings if needed.

Include Your Support Team

- Review all NIL decisions together athlete, parents/guardians, coach, and a trusted advisor (like Esquire Sports).
- Never let your athlete feel pressured or alone in negotiations.
- Attend NIL education events, workshops, and team meetings—stay informed.



Check in Regularly

- Make NIL review part of your season: what's working, what's stressful, and how can you help.
- If you hit a snag—contract, social media, or new opportunity reach out to your school, coach, or Esquire Sports for real advice.
